ACCREDITATIONS



Château Haut Coulon is the smallest estate of Châteaux & Domaines Castel, covering only 3.86 hectares in Sainte-Eulalie. This unique vineyard sits on an exceptional geological treasure: rare blue montmorillonite clay soils, rich in minerals, combined with limestone with asterisks. The estate is carefully cultivated and raised like a Grand Cru.

CULTURAL ITINERARY

- Mechanical cavaillon maintenance.
- 100% grassing (mowing between the rows of vines).
- Pest control using sexual confusion. Double Guyot pruning.
- Green harvesting (de-budding, lifting).

VINIFICATION & AGING

- Original winemaking.
- Single-varietal plot work throughout vinification and ageing.
- Use of indigenous yeasts selected in the vineyard.
- Extractions controlled by tasting (2 times a day).
- Racking at the start of fermentation in truncated cone tanks.
- Vinification in truncated-cone concrete vats.
- Aged for 12 months in vats (80% of volume) and new French oak barrels (20% of volume).

TASTING NOTES



Deep and brilliant black color with violet reflections.



The nose develops concentrated and greedy fruit aromas, nuanced by subtle spicy and mentholated notes.



In the mouth, the attack is powerful and frank with a very good density. The finish is long with elegance and freshness.

FOOD & WINE PAIRINGS

Delicious juicy cuts of beef, boneless shoulder of lamb cooked with vine shoots or hard cheeses (parmesan...).
